Importance of the U.S. Recycling System

- Recycling provides valuable feedstock to the manufacturing sector.
- Recycling creates jobs! EPA estimates that 757,000 jobs and \$36.6 billion in wages result from recycling.
- National recycling rate has grown from 10% in 1970 to over 35% today.
- EPA's America Recycles Initiative launched in November 2018.



U.S. Recycling System Challenges

- Consumer confusion about how to recycle properly
- Outdated processing infrastructure in need of investment
- Lack of domestic markets
- Differing state and local approaches to collecting, defining, measuring and tracking recycling


