




Local Resident - 30% of journey level hours	Tier 1 Local Residents and Tier 2 Local Residents.
New Apprentice – 40% of apprentice hours	A Local Resident who first enrolled in a state-registered apprenticeship program at time of commencement of Project Work, or within 12 months prior to commencement of project work.
Tier 1 Local Resident	A person residing in the City of Fresno and in the top 5% of disadvantaged communities per CalEnviroScreen 2.0. (See attached map.)
Tier 2 Local Resident	A person residing in Fresno County or Madera County and in the top 5% of disadvantaged communities per CalEnviroScreen 2.0. (See attached map.)
