



Hazardous Waste Program Enacted vs. Inflationary Escalation

*Inflationary escalation is based on an approximate 39% inflation rate from 2010-2023 and then estimating an annual rate which is 2.8%. ECOS is requesting half the actual annual rate of 1.4% to begin to address funding needs. ** Excludes funding for Coal Combustion Residuals (\$3 million in FY21, \$4M in FY22, \$4M in FY23, and \$4M in FY24) and Save Our Seas 2.0 (\$5M in FY24).


