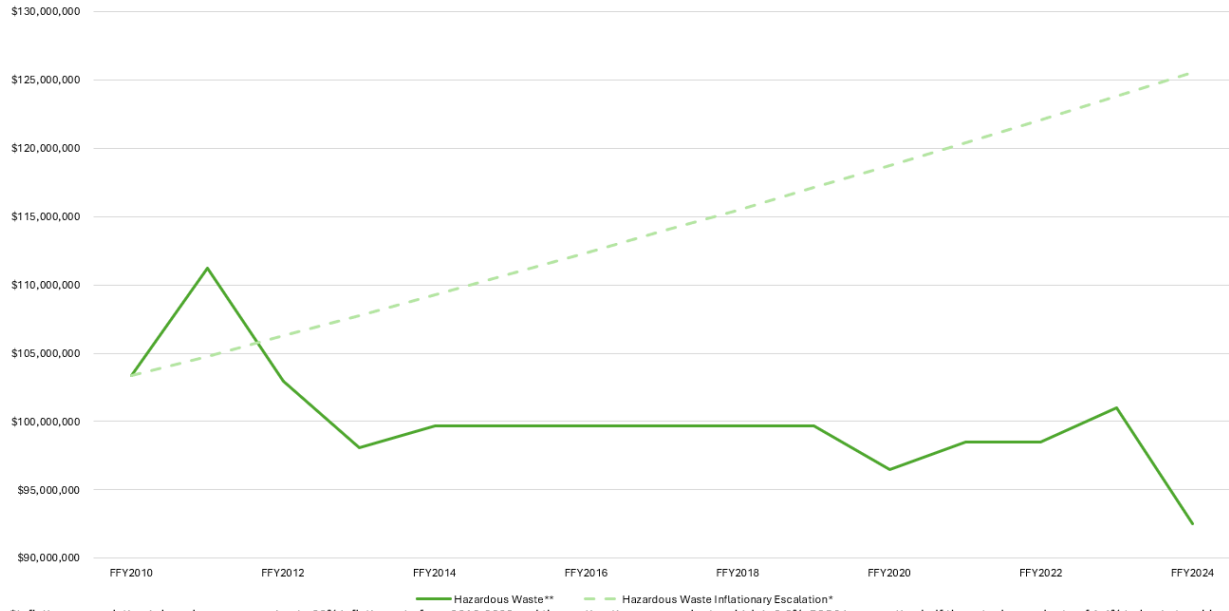

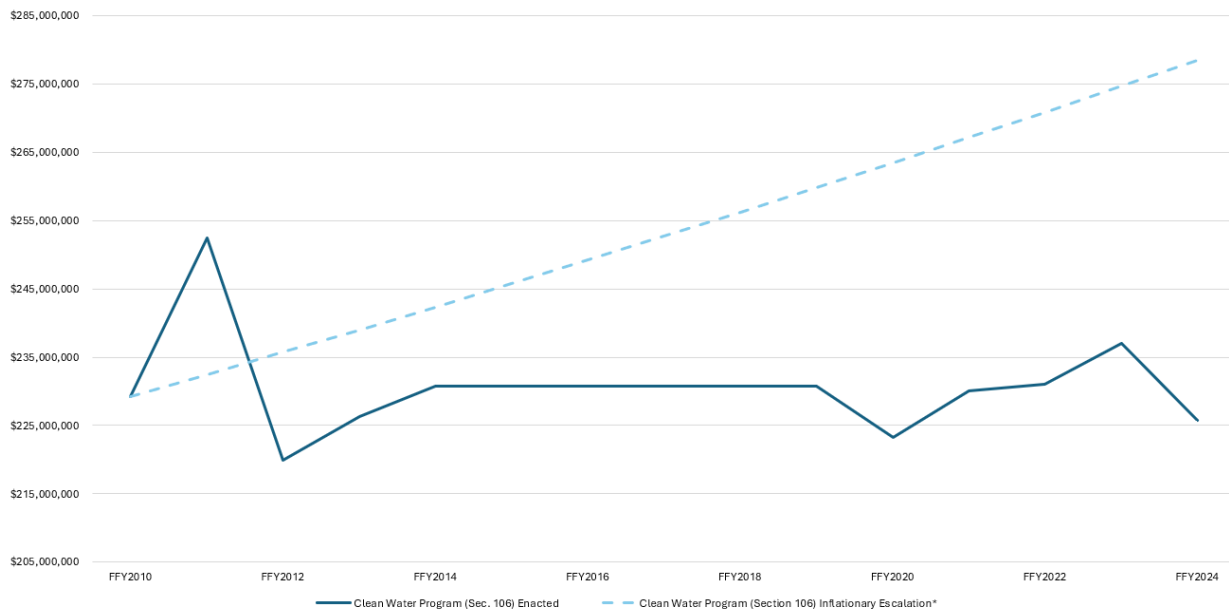
Hazardous Waste Program Enacted vs. Inflationary Escalation

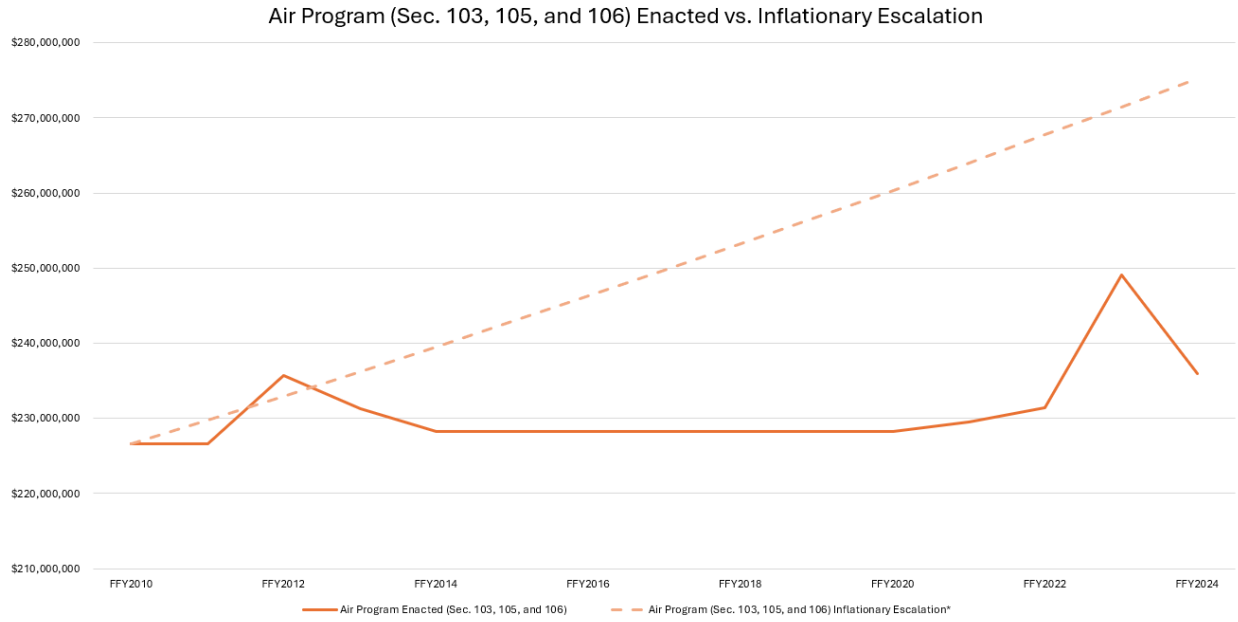
