
Legislative action to implement a take back program



To consolidate & dispose of municipal stocks of legacy AFFF



Self-inventory initiative in 2022 to catalog known stores of AFFF









AFFF Collection

- 104 fire departments, 1 airport participated
- 1,060 containers of Class B foam collected
- Total of 9,924 gallons
- Some foams not accepted





NH PFAS Product Control Program





PFAS Product Control Program

House Bill 1649 (2024)





Restricts the use of PFAS in certain consumer products



Product ban effective January 1, 2027

List of Products

- Carpets or rugs
- Cosmetics
- Textile treatments
- Feminine hygiene products
- Food packaging and containers
- Juvenile products
- Upholstered furniture
- Textile furnishings

Proposed addition in 2025:

HB167 - Waxes produced for use on boats, skis, surfboards, bodyboards, or skimboards
